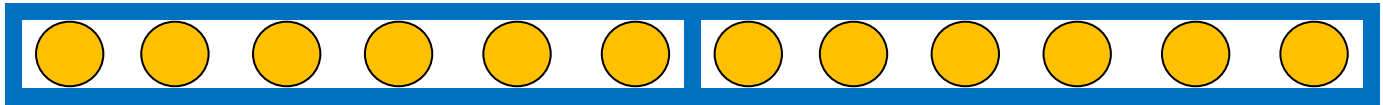

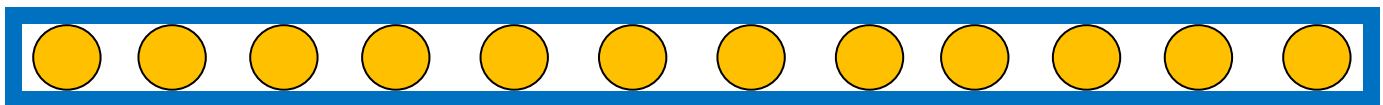

# Règle 1 :

$$2 \times 6 = 12$$

$$A \times B = C$$

$$2 = \frac{12}{6}$$

$$A = \frac{C}{B}$$

## Règle 2 :

$$\frac{N}{D} = R$$

$\frac{20 \text{ €}}{5} = 4 \text{ €}$	$\frac{100 \text{ €}}{5} = 20 \text{ €}$	Si $N \nearrow$ : $R \nearrow$
	$\frac{20 \text{ €}}{10} = 2 \text{ €}$	Si $D \nearrow$ : $R \searrow$
